The scope of this investigation

Goods Concerned

This investigation covers Aluminium Extrusions exported from People's Republic of China (PRC), described as:

The goods under investigation are bars, rods, profiles (whether or not hollow), tubes, pipes; unassembled; whether or not prepared for use in structures (e.g. cut to length, drilled, bent, chamfered, threaded); made from aluminium whether or not alloyed, containing not more than 99.3% aluminium.

The product concerned is commonly referred to as 'aluminium extrusions', referring to its most common manufacturing process even if it can also be produced by other production processes such as rolling, forging or casting.

These Aluminium Extrusions are currently classifiable within the following commodity code(s): 76041010, 76041090, 76042100, 76042910, 76042990, 76081000, 76082081, 76082089 and 76109090.

In this form, these goods will be referred to as 'the goods concerned'. Any reference to 'goods concerned' in this form refers to the goods description above, regardless of the commodity code under which they are exported.

Like goods

Any reference to '**like goods**' in this form refers to goods produced in the UK or imported to the UK from a country other than the People's Republic of China which are like the goods concerned in all respects, or with characteristics closely resembling them.

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) is responsible for investigating the allegation that Aluminium Extrusions from the People's Republic of China (PRC) are being exported to the United Kingdom (UK) at prices less than their normal value and that this dumping (sales at less than normal value) is causing injury to the UK industry for these goods.

I – Why you are being asked to complete this form

We are seeking your cooperation as an interested party or a contributor, who wishes to participate in this investigation by providing information to help TRA conduct this investigation. The information your organisation provides will help us determine a fair and appropriate response which is in the UK's overall interest. ABL (Aluminium Components) Limited is an Independent UK Processor and Distributor of aluminium semi-finished extruded products to UK Manufacturing businesses.

We currently buy from both UK and Chinese sources and whilst price differentials occur, these are mostly influenced by Foreign Exchange fluctuations, Metal Premiums and transportation costs, certainly not discounted or dumped material costs. Today, new purchases from China would land at higher prices than we can source from UK and Europe, and this is without any anti-dumping measures in place. It is critical that we are allowed to source from the most competitive producers unhindered irrespective of which continent they reside on.

Our UK customers (who cover the entire spectrum from Sole-Trader businesses to Global Multi-Nationals) demand high quality, competitively priced and timely deliveries of materials that enable them to further manufacture products competitively in domestic and export markets.

Should Chinese (or any other country's) material be excluded from the market by anti-dumping duties, this will put additional strain on the existing UK and European supply base that is already pushing lead times out and raising prices on a weekly basis.

Approximately 70% of the product we manufacture ultimately ends up being exported by our UK customers, some of which have alternative manufacturing sites around the globe and we see any reduction in our and their competitiveness as a huge threat to the supply chain and thus a threat to 'UK Manufacturing plc' in general.
