



## Anti-dumping Investigation No. AD0012

Anti-dumping investigation in respect of aluminium extrusions imported into the United Kingdom originating in the People's Republic of China.

### Note to the file

#### Publication of the Provisional Affirmative Determination and Statement of Essential Facts

This note is published to the public file to notify parties that the TRA has published the Provisional Affirmative Determination (PAD) and Statement of Essential Facts (SEF).

The PAD contains the TRA's recommendation to the Secretary of State for International Trade (the Secretary of State). The Secretary of State has agreed that provisional measures should be put in place to prevent injury being caused during the investigation to the UK industry. The findings are set out in Table 1 in **Annex 1**.

The provisional measures in the PAD were based on the best information available to the TRA at the point at which the recommendation was made to the Secretary of State. Importers will be required to have bank guarantees in place for imports from **28 May 2022**. The guarantees will be administered by HMRC and today they will issue a notice announcing this.

The provisional measures will be in place for a period of 6 months or until the investigation terminates, whichever is the sooner. If a final decision is made to apply measures, importers will be liable to pay duties at the level set out in the final decision, applicable from the date the PAD came into effect (28 May).

In parallel we are publishing the SEF, which is our full assessment based on detailed verification of the data. The findings of the SEF are set out in Table 2 in **Annex 1**.

The SEF represents our intended final determinations however these are subject to change and do not alter the provisional measures which have been agreed by the Secretary of State that shall take effect from 28 May 2022. Where findings in the SEF differ from those in the PAD, explanations can be found in the SEF.
