Notification of sampling approach

Due to the small number of responses in both the registration period and to the pre-sampling questionnaire, the Secretary of State for International Trade (the Secretary of State) will **not** limit examination of overseas exporters/importers/UK producers at this stage. It may become necessary to limit examination to a sample of these categories if further submissions are received.

This notice is not intended to preclude the Secretary of State from limiting examination to a sample of transactions for the purchase of like goods or directly competitive goods.

In detail, the sampling approach for overseas exporters, UK producers and importers in this review is defined below.

Overseas exporter sampling:

No sampling needed: The small number of parties/responses to the pre-sampling questionnaire means the Secretary of State does not consider it appropriate to limit examination regarding exporters.

UK producer sampling:

No sampling needed: The small number of parties/responses to the pre-sampling questionnaire means the Secretary of State does not consider it appropriate to limit examination regarding UK producers.

Importer sampling:

No sampling needed: The small number of parties/responses to the pre-sampling questionnaire means the Secretary of State does not consider it appropriate to limit examination regarding importers.
