Comments on the Notice to Interested Parties and Contributors on Withdrawal of UK Producer Interest in Maintaining the Current Measure regarding Anti-dumping Duty on Certain Pre- and Post-stressing Wires and Wire Strands of Non-alloy Steel (PSC Wires and Strands) originating in the People's Republic of China

Dear Investigator,

We recall the Notice published on the Trade Remedy Service on February 4, 2021 concerning the confirmation received from the UK producer on January 27, 2021 that the UK Industry no longer has an interest in maintaining the measure related to this transition review.

In the light of regulation 98(6) of Part 12 of the Trade Remedies (Dumping and Subsidisation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019, it must be considered in a transition review on anti-dumping duty whether "there would be injury to the UK industry in those goods if an anti-dumping amount were no longer to apply to those goods".

According to the Notice, the UK industry has explicitly expressed their position that they have no interest to maintain the effect of the EU anti-dumping measure. Based on the UK industry's confirmation, we believe that cease of application of the measure will not cause negative impact on the UK Industry or economic interest of the UK, otherwise they would insist to maintain the application.

According to the situation mentioned above, we hereby respectfully request the Department for International Trade to determine that the measure is not necessary nor appropriate for the UK and therefore decide to cease application of the measure.
