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# The scope of this review

### Goods subject to review

This review covers certain aluminium road wheels originating from the People's Republic of China (PRC), described as: aluminium road wheels of motor vehicles per commodity code headings 8701 to 8705, whether or not with accessories and whether or not fitted with tyres.

These aluminium road wheels are currently classifiable within the following commodity codes:

8708 701015

8708 701050

8708 705015

8708 705050

These commodity codes are only given for information.

In this pre-sampling questionnaire, these goods originating from PRC, will be referred to as the **goods subject to review**. Any reference to the goods subject to review in this pre-sampling questionnaire refers to the goods description above, regardless of the commodity codes under which they are exported.

# Like goods

This pre-sampling questionnaire asks for information about your company's imports and sales of goods which are **like** the goods subject to review. Any reference to '**like goods**' in this pre-sampling questionnaire refers to goods produced in the UK or imported to the UK from a country other than the People's Republic of China which are like the goods subject to review in all respects, or with characteristics closely resembling them.

Please follow the instructions for each question to provide the appropriate information regarding the goods subject to review or like goods.



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### Instructions

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) will be carrying out a transition review of each trade remedy measure active under the EU system that the United Kingdom (UK) has decided to transition after EU exit. This transition review will consider whether the anti-dumping measure for aluminium road wheels of motor vehicles per commodity code headings 87 01 to 87 05, whether or not with accessories and whether or not fitted with tyres, from the People's Republic of China is necessary or sufficient to offset dumping and whether there would be injury to the UK industry if that measure was removed.

# I – Why you are being asked to complete this pre-sampling questionnaire

We are seeking your cooperation as a **UK producer** to inform our review of whether the current anti-dumping measure should be maintained, varied or discontinued.

This pre-sampling questionnaire allows us to collect basic information and data about your company. If a large number of UK producers complete this pre-sampling questionnaire, we will use the information each one provides to help us decide which companies we want to sample for further investigation. If you are sampled, we will send you a more detailed questionnaire to complete.

  - 1) Due to conversion losses the actual sales weight of product is much lower than the production weight of the initial forgings as approx. 80% of the input material is converted into waste.
  - A second disparity occurs when comparing production weights in B1 to the data included in section B2 as a high proportion of our product is exported outside of the UK.
  - 3) Data in Section B3 does not include semi finished product imported from non China regions.
  - 4) Imports vs Sales difference assumes 2% loss for test and quality check.
  - 5) 2020-2021 was a transition year where Rimstock ceased production of cast wheels and began importing them instead. Product traceability is not detailed enough to be able to determine whether product sold in the POI is all imported product or has a small amount of residual UK produced stock. The information given has been prepared using our best endeavours but may have an inaccuracy level of +/- 2%, however this isn't significant enough to affect the overall business landscape.
