Incomplete questionnaire submission - Liberty Steel

Following the publication of a Notice of Initiation on 24 June 2022, the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) is conducting a transition review (TD0026) of a UK trade remedies measure in relation to Hot Rolled Flat products of iron, non-alloy steel or other alloy steel originating in the Russian Federation, Ukraine, Federative Republic of Brazil & Islamic Republic of Iran.

Liberty Steel registered its interest in this case on 14 July 2022.

The TRA has requested parties to provide non-confidential versions of the questionnaires in line with the [TRA's guidance on non-confidential information](#).

The TRA received from Liberty an incomplete non-confidential version of the questionnaire, which has been placed on the public file.

The TRA engaged and discussed with Liberty, the content of the questionnaire. Liberty has informed us that it is unable to make amendments, primarily due to other priorities, including engagement on other trade remedies cases, and constrained resources. The TRA is unable to verify the information provided in the questionnaire.
