Note to the file

Note to interested parties and contributors

This note to the file is to inform interested parties whose submissions were made after the expiry of the time limit to comment on the Statement of Intended Preliminary Decision (SIPD) that have not been published on the public file, have not been considered when making determinations at the conclusion of this transition review and have not been referred to within said determinations pursuant to regulation 19(2) of The Trade Remedies (Increase in Imports Causing Serious Injury to UK Producers) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019.

In response to the SIPD, the TRA received submissions from a number of parties which are published on the public file. Due to the timeframes for the completion of this transition review, the TRA was unable to extend the deadline for submissions beyond 5pm (BST) on 26 May 2021. Therefore, any submissions made to the TRA and received after 26 May 2021 have not been included in the Determinations of the TRA and the TRA's Recommendation to the Secretary of State for International Trade, as listed below:

British Steel Limited Copper Coated Coil Limited Chris Green MP Ernest Bennett SHEARLINE STEEL STRIP Limited UK Steel (EEF)

Further, the case team did not consider submissions from Duferco UK Limited, Chris Green MP, Christina Rees MP, Marion Fellows MP and Swann-Morton Limited, which the TRA received by the deadline but on which the TRA received a confirmation that the submissions were not confidential after it was able to include them. The TRA exercised its discretion and assessed whether the content of the submissions would be material and decided that, given the content in the submissions was consistent with that given in other submissions, the underlying information had already been taken into account.
