This note to the file is in addition to the note to file made on 10 June 2021 with regard to submissions made after the expiry of the time limit to comment on the Statement of Intended Preliminary Decision (SIPD) that have not been published on the public file, have not been considered when making determinations at the conclusion of this transition review and have not been referred to within said determinations pursuant to regulation 19(2) of The Trade Remedies (Increase in Imports Causing Serious Injury to UK Producers) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019.

In response to the SIPD, the TRA received submissions from a number of parties which are published on the public file. Due to the timeframes for the completion of this transition review, the TRA was unable to extend the deadline for submissions beyond 5pm (BST) on 26 May 2021. Therefore, any submissions made to the TRA and received after 26 May 2021 have not been included in the Determinations of the TRA and the TRA's Recommendation to the Secretary of State for International Trade. In addition to those listed in the note to file of 10 June 2021, the following are added to the list:

Celsa Steel UK Copper Coated Coil Limited FT Pipeline Systems Ltd

Further, the case team considered another submission that was not listed in the Recommendation but was received within the necessary timeframe and was therefore considered. This submission was received from Holly Mumby-Croft MP on 25 May 2021. This submission is now published on the public file.
