The China Building Materials Federation (formerly China Building Materials Industry Association) was established in 1985. The China Building Materials Federation is a national social organization that is voluntarily composed by enterprises, institutions and organizations in China's building materials industry, cross-regional and inter-departmental, approved by the Ministry of Civil Affairs, and managed by the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council and has more than 1,500 members.

The China Building Materials Federation has 9 subordinate units and 16 branches, which manage 23 national building materials professional associations.

The main tasks are: Advising government departments on economic policies and legislation; reflecting members and corporate demands, organizing rules and regulations, stopping low-cost dumping and disorderly competition, standardizing corporate behavior, establishing industry self-regulatory mechanisms, and safeguarding industry and corporate legality Equity; provide timely and accurate information on industrial policies, standards, technology, investment, exhibitions, training and etc; formulate industry planning and development strategies, and formulate revised national standards and industry standards and other related industry management tasks Innovate and apply new industrial policies, standards and technologies to lead the scientific development of the industry; strengthen links with foreign peers, conduct foreign economic and technological exchanges and cooperation, coordinate and resolve trade frictions and economic disputes; organize domestic and international trade fairs and exhibitions to help companies develop markets;
